She has given speeches on TV, the radio and all around the world – from Britain, France, Switzerland, Germany, Holland, Belgium, Russia, the Channel Islands, Canada, to the U.S. She has also worked for the BBC, where she met her husband and then worked behind the “**Iron Curtain**”, Opera Mundi.
